Scholarship Details:

Description:	A one-year scholarship available to Mount Zion Baptist Church members who have received their Right Hand of Fellowship prior to June 1, 2014, who will be enrolled in an institution of higher learning during the 2016-2017 school year. The Mount Zion Baptist Church Scholarship Ministry's mission is to encourage and award academic excellence and Christ-like service.
Award Amount:	Determined by the Scholarship Ministry, based on a point system for each section of the application (priority given to undergraduate students). Doctoral candidates' awards shall not exceed \$500 per academic year.
Academic Year:	2016-2017
Award Notification	Sunday, July 17, 2016. All awards will be mailed directly to the college.
Application Deadline:	Applications must be postmarked no later than Friday, June 17, 2016-NO EXCEPTIONS
Application Method:	<p>Mail completed applications to: Mount Zion Baptist Church Attn: Scholarship Ministry 1634 19th Ave Seattle, WA 98144</p> <p>The Scholarship Ministry will ONLY accept applications sent via US mail that are postmarked by Friday, June 17, 2016. Applications left in the church office, Scholarship Ministry Mailbox or given to a Scholarship Ministry member will NOT be accepted for consideration under any circumstances.</p> <p>The Scholarship Ministry <i>strongly</i> suggests that you mail your applications inside of a post office or other mailing center and obtain proof of mailing. Should there be any discrepancies (application lost in the mail, etc.), the Scholarship Review Committee will rely <i>only</i> on your proof of mailing to make a determination. It is also recommended that applicants keep a full copy of their application.</p>
Renewable:	No, applicants must re-apply annually with a maximum of 5 total awards

Type of Student	High School seniors, undergraduate, and graduate students
Situations Funded:	Tuition and books only
School Type:	Colleges, universities, community colleges, and technical schools
Enrollment Status	Full-time, part-time
Application Requirements:	<p>Applicant must be <i>currently</i> active in church activities and attend Mount Zion regularly (or a church in their college town). Verification of this <i>must</i> be provided via a letter of reference from a ministry head in your church (see section D (2) of the application).</p> <p>Applicant must support or commit to supporting the Mount Zion Scholarship Ministry via their time, talents, and/or resources.</p>

Application Requirements (Continued):	<p>Proof of enrollment from the institution applicant is scheduled to attend during the 2016-2017 school year.</p> <p>Most recent <u>official sealed</u> college or high school transcripts (for incoming college Freshman)</p> <p>Two references must be included with the application; one academic reference (on school letterhead or via <u>school faculty email</u>) and one church reference (must be from ministry chair describing how the applicant is <u>currently</u> involved in the ministry they chair-no recommendations from relatives will be accepted). Do <u>not</u> mail separately.</p>
GPA Requirements:	Minimum GPA of 2.0
